act, as the Town shall think proper when Met
- 3^d To fill up Vacancies in those Town Offices, which the Law
requires, should any office appear to be Vacant,
- 4th To see, if the Town will (agreeable to the request of Mr. Abel
Moore,) accept of some suitable person, for a Collector of Taxes
in said Town, for the Year ensuing, in the room of said
Moore, said Collector, giving Bond, to the acceptance of the
Selectmen, & Town Treas^r, to Do, or act &c
- 5th To see, if the Town, will attend to any or all of the reports,
to be made by Committees should any such reports be of-
-fer'd to be made, to do or act &c
- 6th To see, if the Town, will Cut up six Seats, in the Meeting House
in said Town, for the purpose of Building Pews on, three Seats
to be taken upon each Side of the pulpit, Next the walls,
in the Body said House, to do or act, &c &c
- 7th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for setting of trees
upon each Side of this Towns proportion, of the Long Causeway.
