for the Interest of the Town, — Committee appointed were
M^r. Isaac Puffer, M^r. Jed^d. Thompson, & M^r. Elijah Jones.

4th Article directed the Selectmen, to act as they shall think best
respecting the setting of trees, & what kind; upon each Side
of this Towns proportion, of the Long Causway, as Mentio-
— oned in this article,

3^d Article then Capt. Abel Cutting, desir'd serving as one of the
School committee, & Capt. Daniel Bowker was appointed in
his stead

— Then the Town, agreeable to the request of Ruben Maynard,
excus'd him from serving as one of the School-committee
& M^r. Aaron Haynes, was appointed in his room,

5th Attended to the report, of the committee, appointed, in Nov^r.
last, for the purpose of Viewing and making, the exchange
of a couple of small pieces of Ministerial Land, for a couple
of small pieces of land belonging to M^r. Eben^r. Plympton, who
reported, that each party had been on to view said pieces of
Land, that this was agreeable to their estimation about two
hundred Rods, of Ministerial land, which lay in with M^r. —
Plympton, & that M^r. Plympton was willing to give in ex-
— change as many rods of his land, which they Judged to be
equally as good, & better wooded; which report was accepted

— also appointed Caleb Pona Que, as an agent, for the pur-
— pose of passing a Deed, in behalf of the Town, of the said
Ministerial land, to M^r. Plympton, & to receive a Deed of
said Plympton, of his said Pieces of land, to be given in be-
— half of the Town, each Deed to, describe the said pieces of
land, by Intelligable, Butts & bounds, so as to prevent dis-
— putty hereafter,

3^d Then the Town took up this article again, and agreeable to the
request of Capt Bowker, excus'd him from serving on the Se-
— school com^{tee} & M^r. William Smith was chosen in his place

— also at the request of Lt Caleb Wheeler, excus'd him from ser-
— ving as one of the School Com^{tee} & Capt. Sam^l. Puffer Jr.,
was appointed in his stead,

— Then the Town by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting —
