

May Anno Domini, 1805

These are to Notify, & warn, all the Male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, being twenty One years of age, & resident in said Town, for the space of One year Next preceding, having a Freehold Estate with in said Town, of the annual Income, of three Pounds, or any Estate to the Value of sixty Pounds, to Meet, at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 6th day of May Next, at 1 o'clock, in the afternoon, for the purpose of choosing a Representative, to represent them at the General Court, appointed to be convened, & held at Boston, on the last Wednesday of May Next.

Also all the Freeholders & other Inhabitants of said Town Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the above mentioned place, & time, to act on the following Articles Vizt.
1st To choose a Moderator, & act upon the 4th Article, in the warning of Nov^r Meeting, & refer'd to March, & so on to April, and so on to May Meeting, for further consideration, also the 4th Article, in the warning of April Meeting, and refer'd to May Meeting, for further Consideration.

2^d To Bring in Town Debts, & Credit

3^d To see, if the Town will grant, to their Rev^d Minister his salary, for the year ensuing — and also to make an additional Grant to their Rev^d Minister, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met,

4th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the support of a Grammar school, the year ensuing, & order where the same shall be kept, — Do — or act, &c &c

5th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the support of a Reading & writing school, the year ensuing, and Order where the same shall be kept, to do — or act, &c &c

6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the relief of the Poor, belonging to said Town, the year ensuing

7th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Treas^r and Assessors, the present year, — to do — or — act, &c &c

8th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable person, to take care of, and sweep the Meeting-House, ring the Bell, and Dig graves, as Occasion may require, the year ensuing, — Do — or act, &c &c

9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for Opening the Road, leading from M^r Benjamin Dudleys, Over to the Widow Ekanor Browns, agreeable to the request, of M^r David Trull, — to — or — act &c &c
