

May Anno Domini 1805.

12th Article Voted that the same encouragement be given to those persons who shall use the means for destroying of Crows as was given the year last past, & to be under the same rules and regulations as was adhered to the preceding year.

It was then voted, to adjourn this Meeting unto the 3rd Monday in June next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon to meet at this place.

Sudbury Monday June 7th 1805.

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing adjournment. 1st Proceeded to the business of said day. — & the Question was put, to see, if the Town would take up the 4th Article in the warning of Nov^r. Meeting, & refered to march, & April, & so on 4th to May Meeting, as contain'd in this 1st Article and it pass'd in the Negative. — The Question was again put, to see, if the Town would take up this 4th Article, to act upon and it pass'd in the affirmative.

It was then voted to adjourn this Meeting for the space of twenty minutes, then to meet at this place, in order that the Clerk might have an opportunity of procuring the laws of this Commonwealth for the purpose of having the Law respecting the Making of Town Grants read before said Town, in open Town Meeting. — The Town being Mett at time and place agreeable to the foregoing adjournment. Proceeded & took up the 4th Article in the Warning, of Nov^r. Meeting, and refered to March, April, & so on to May Meeting, for further consideration, as contain'd in this 1st Article and the Question was put, to see, if the Town would go into the Measures of Opening, & making the Road, beginning at New Line there running through the Northerly part of the Town, as far as Lee's Bridge, so called, as express'd in this Article, & it pass'd in the affirmative.

It was then voted, to appoint a Committee for the purpose of viewing, and pointing out the way and manner of making said Road, and receiving proposals, of any person, or persons, who shall be disposed to undertake the Making said road, either in both, or the whole, as shall appear to them most for the Interest of the Town, & report to the Town, at some future Meeting, for their acceptance or re-
jection, said Committee to consist of five Persons, and the Selectmen, were appointed, for the purposes aforesaid, —
