

July Anno Domini 1805,

These are to Notify and warn, all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town on Monday the 1st Day of July next, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, on said Day, then and there, to act on the following Articles Vizt

1st To Choose a Moderator

2^d To see, if the Town, will grant, to the several persons hereafter named (the several Sums of Money, as Carried out against each persons Name, it being in full, for an assessment or damages, allowed by a Courts Committee, for Land taken from them for the benefit of a Highway) Vizt, Messieurs Sam^l and Noah Wheeler, Asa Puffer, James Puffer, Hope Brown, Capt^l Bowker, Ben^l Rice, William Smith, and Benjamin Smith, to Do or act as the Town, shall think best, when Met,

3^d To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable Sum of Money for the purpose of Making the Road in the Northwly part of the Town, beginning at Otter Linn, thence Running on to Lees Bridge (so called) to Do or act &c &c

4th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable Sum of Money for the purpose of Making some further Repairs, of the publick Road, belonging to said Town, to Do or act &c &c

5th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of widening ~~the~~ any, or all the publick Roads belonging to said Town, Agreeably, to their Original Laying out, agreeable to the Request of Capt^l Daniel Bowker, and Others, to Do or act &c &c
