

July Anno Domini 1805.

Sudbury Monday July 1st 1805, at a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on the Day, and year abovementioned, proceeded to the business of said day, and made choice of Col. Jos. Rice for their Moderator.

then proceeded, and took up the 2^d Article, & 2^d Article Granted to ^{Messrs} Sam^l & Noah Wheeler the sum of \$33.00

To M^r. Asa Puffer the sum of \$100.00

To M^r. James Puffer the sum of \$20.00

Granted to M^r. Hope Bronson, the old Road beginning at M^r. Asa Puffer's Gate, thence running as far as the corner of S^d Bronson's wall against his Barn, it being in full compensation to him, for the Land taken from him, by a Courts Com^{tee} for the benefit of a Road passing through his Land, the aforesaid grant, of the old road, being at said Bronson's Request, and in lieu of the \$30 App^d as damages by the Courts Com^{tee} for said Road.

To Capt. Daniel Bowker the sum of \$20.00

To M^r. Benjamin Rice the sum of \$10.00

To M^r. William Smith the sum of \$100.00

To M^r. Benjamin Smith the sum of \$210.00

The aforesaid sums of Money, granted to the several persons abovementioned, being in full, for an App^dment as damages, App^d by a Courts Com^{tee} for Land taken from them, for the benefit of a Highway passing through their Land.

Then Voted, to call upon the Com^{tee} for Report appointed for the purpose of viewing and receiving proposals respecting the New Road, in the Northerly part of the Town, who reported, they had been upon said Road, and that it was their Opinion, it might be made tolerable good, for the sum of 600 or 700 Dollars, that there was a Number of persons came forward, and offered to take said road, from Concord Line as far as M^r. Isaac Puffer's, for the sum of about \$600 that there was no other proposals made by any person, for the making the remainder part of said Road, but it was their Opinion the other part from M^r. Puffer's to Stow Line would be nearly, if not altogether as expensive.

3^d Article, after a Considerable Debate, had upon the Subject Matter of this article, the Question was put to see if the Town would grant, the sum of \$700 for the purpose of Making the Road in the Northerly part of the Town to be worked.
