worked out by a Highway Rate, & it passed in the Negative

The Question was then put, to see if the Town would grant the sum of \$600, to be put under the direction of a committee and to be apply'd in that way & manner, as will be most for the Interest of the Town in making the road, in the northerly part of the Town, and it passed in the Negative. — Then voted, to pass over this 3^d Article for the present, & took up the 4th Article and granted the sum of \$1000, for the purpose of Repairing Lancaster & Worcester Roads, (so called), to be made into a Highway Rate and expended in Labour, upon said roads \$ 1000

3^d Article Then the Town took up this 3^d Article again, & the Question was put to see, if the Town would grant the sum of \$1000, to be made into a Highway rate, & expended upon the New Road in the northerly part of the Town, and it passed in the Negative

Then the Town by their vote, Granted the sum of \$800, for the purpose of Making the Road as Express in this Article, said Grant to be made into a Highway Rate, and apply'd in Labour, for the benefit of making said road.

It was then voted, that the aforesaid sum, of \$1800 Granted for the purpose of Repairing & making the public Roads in said Town, be made into a Highway Rate, and apportion'd out by the Selectmen agreeable to appropriations, — also voted, that the price of Labour with regard to Men, oxen & carts &c. be the same as was established in the last Highway Rate — also voted, that the aforesaid Grants of Money be expended in Labour, on the several roads between the first Day of September, and the first Day of December, Next ensuing

The Question was then ask'd to see, if the Town would grant the sum of \$100, for the purpose of making the Bridges and Sluices necessary to be made, on the New road, and it passed in the Negative

Then the Town, by their vote Dissolved this Meeting
