These are to Notify, and warn all the Freeholders, and other In-
habitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs,
to Vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House, in said
Town, on Monday the 18th Day of this Instant Nov^r. at 1.
o'clock, in the Afternoon, on said day then & there, to act
on the following Articles (Viz^t)

- 1st To Choose a Moderator
- 2^d To see, if the Town will appoint an agent, or agents, in behalf
of said Town, to wait on a Committee, appointed by the Hon^{ble}
Court of Sessions, for the purpose of straitening, and Laying out
a Road in the Southerly part of said Town, to point out to said
Committee, a shorter and more eligible Route, than has been
shown, to said Com^{tee} by the Petitioners, for said straitenings,
to Do - or act, as the Town shall think proper when Met,
- 3^d To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the purpose of
Making any further Repairs, to the New County road lead-
ing through the Northerly part of said Town, to do, or act &c.
- 4th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the purpose of
Preventing Ephraim Hayden, and family becoming expensive
to said Town, - to Do - or - act, &c. &c.
- 5th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable person, or
Persons, and authorise him, or them, to pass Deeds, in behalf
of said Town (of those Piers lately erected in the Meeting-House
in said Town,) to the several Purchasers of said Piers - also
to see, if the Town will appropriate the Money arising
from the sale of said Piers, - to Do - or - act, &c. &c.
