4th The Town by their Vote directed their Treas^r to pay out of
the Treasury any Money, Now in the Treasury and un-
=appropriated, the contents of an execution return ag-
=ainst said Town, as express under this article &c —
it being supposed, to be to the amount of about \$50 —

2^d Article, Then the Town took up this article again, and
appropriated the sum of \$10, out of any unappro-
=priated Money Now in the Treasury, to Enable their
agent, (appointed under this article) to appear in behalf of
the Town, at the Court of General Sessions, to oppose the ac-
=ceptance of the Road Mentiond in this article, he to be
accountable to the Town for the expenditure thereof

Then the Town by Vote, Dissolved this Meeting, —
