

These are to Notify and warn, all the Freeholders, and Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to meet, at the Meeting House, in said Town, On Monday the 3^d Day of March Next at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, on said Day, then and there, to act on the following Articles (Viz^t) ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town Officers, Required by Law, to be annually Chosen, in the Months of March, or April, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

2^d To see, if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate the present year, and Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the same ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Swine to go at large, the present year ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

4th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for Horses to go at large without fetters, any part of the present year from the first day of April, to the last day of Sept^r, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for Sheep to go at large, from the 15th Day of March, to the first day of May next, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

6th To see, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r and Order the same to be recorded, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

7th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable persons for a School Committee, and authorize them, to agree with and Hire School-Instructors, to Instruct the Publick School in said Town, the year ensuing, to do or act as the Town shall think best when met, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

8th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable Person, or persons, for Collector, or Collectors, to collect the Taxes, Assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing, ~ do or act, &c. &c. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

9th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for Opening the Road Leading from M^r. Don^a. Fairbanks, to M^r. John Perrys Saw Mill — it being agreeable to the request of M^r. Ezekiel Parmenter, to do, or act &c. &c. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
