

April Anno Domini 1806.

These are to notify and warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified as is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to Vote, in the choice of Gov^r Lt Gov^r and Senators, for the year ensuing and all others Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House in said Town, on Monday the 7th Day of April next, at 1 o'clock in the Afternoon, on said day, then and there, to act on the following Articles, Viz^t —

- 1st To Bring in their Votes, for the choice of Gov^r Lt Gov^r and Senators, for the year ensuing
- 2^d To Choose a Moderator, — and act upon the 6th 7th 8th and 10th Articles in the warning of March Meeting & refer'd to April Meeting for further Consideration, to do or act, as the Town shall think best when Mett.
- 3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town Officers, which the Law Requires, should any Office appear to be Vacant.
- 4th To see if the Town will give Liberty for Shreat Cattle to go at large, the present year, to do or act &c &c
- 5th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for ascertaining the Bounds of the Road leading from M^r. Jonⁿ. Fairbanks to M^r. John Perry as far as the same goes, and to lay out a Road the remainder of the way, to M^r. Perry's land, Near his saw Mill, — it being agreeable to the request of M^r. Ezekiel Parmenter; to do or act &c &c
- 6th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of erecting Guide Posts, in such particular places in the Town, as they shall Judge Necessary, agreeable to the requisitions of the Law, in that behalf made and provided. to do or act &c &c
- 7th To see if the Town will, (Agreeable to the request of William Rice Esq^r) give their Treas^r any Particular Directions, for the purpose of Collecting the Taxes, that remain due the Town, in the Federal Constables, and Collectors Hands, belonging to said Town, to do, or act, &c
