These are to Notify, and warn, the Male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury being twenty One years of age and resident in said Town for the space of one year, Next ensuing, having a Freehold Estate within said Town, of the annual Income of three Pounds, or any estate to the Value of sixty Pounds to meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 5th Day of May Next, at 1. o'clock in the afternoon, on said Day, for the purpose of Choosing a Representative, to Represent them, at the General Court, appointed to be convened and held at Boston, on the last Wednesday of May Next, —

— also all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as the Law directs to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet at the abovementioned ~~place~~ place at 2. o'clock in the afternoon, on said day, to act on the following Articles, Viz^{article}

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, and act upon the 9th in the warning of April Meeting and refer to May Meeting for further Consideration, to do or act as the Town shall think best when met.
- 2^d To bring in Town Debts, and Credit —
- 3^d To see, if the Town, will Grant to their Rev^d Minister his salary for the year ensuing — and also to make an additional Grant to their Rev^d Minister, to do or act as
- 4th To see, if the Town will Grant Money, for the support of a Grammar School the year Ensuing and Order where the same shall be kept to do or act &c &c
