

May Anno Domini 1806.

7<sup>th</sup> Art. Granted to pay their Treas<sup>r</sup> the present year \$ 10. " "

To Pay their expenses the present year the sum of \$ 15. " "

8<sup>th</sup> The Town by their vote, directed the select-  
men, to agree with, & hire some suit-  
able person to perform the service men-  
tioned in this article.

9<sup>th</sup> Passed over for the Present.

10<sup>th</sup> The Question was put, to see if the Town would  
grant the sum of \$ 50. for the purposes expressd in  
this article, and it pass'd in the Negative.

The Question was then put to see if the Town would  
grant any sum of Money for the purpose expressd  
in this article, and it pass'd in the affirmative.

The Question was then put, to see if the Town would  
grant the sum of \$ 45. for the purposes expressd in  
this article, and to be expended in the following Man-  
ner Viz<sup>t</sup> the school to be kept One and an half  
week in each of the four out school districts, Provid-  
ed there is a sufficient Number of Scholars, that  
appear to be willing to attend said schools, as will be  
worth attending to by said Instructor, and One fort-  
night in the Centre district — also under the same  
Question the sum of \$ 25. was proposed for the pur-  
pose of purchasing a Base Vial for said Society and  
both of said Questions pass'd in the Negative.

It was then voted, to grant the sum of \$ 45. for the  
purpose expressd under this Article and to be expend-  
ed in the following Manner Viz<sup>t</sup> said school to be  
kept One & an half week in each of the four out school  
districts, provided there is a sufficient Number of  
Scholars in each of said districts that will attend said  
schools, as will be worth attending to by said In-  
structor, and One fortnight at the Close of the school  
to be kept in the centre district \$ 45.

11<sup>th</sup> Then the Town, took up this article again and by their  
vote, appropriated a sum of Money sufficient to  
answer the immediate demands of such persons as  
have accounts against said Town, to be paid out of  
any unappropriated Money, that shall be in the  
Treasury.
