 To Doctor Norman for Stones to Cover a Slue — 1. 00

 also to have the privilege of taking a sufficient Quantity to Gravel, to make the road good as far as Capt. Gibbs —

 To M^r. Isaac Puffer, for two Guide posts for the New County road, in the northerly part of the Town — 2. 50

 To M^r. John Goodnow Jr for One old Crow — 1. 25
 To M^r. Paul Walker, for plank to Cover a Bridge — 1. 35
 To M^r. Eben^r. Plympton, for a Gless for the Box to hold the Warrants in, for warning Town Meetings \$1. 45 } 1. 45

 To Capt. Daniel N. Smith, for Building a New wheel to the Bell, \$8. 67 — and to building New gates to the burying yard, & painting the same \$2. 60, } 11. 27
 — also for Superintending the painting the Meeting House — \$1. 50. — } 1. 50
 To M^r. Eliab Stone for Gravel to repair the Worcester road (so called) & putting up the fence — 10. 50
