- Point which is proposed, which will be more for the Interest of the Town; as set forth in a petition signed by Mr. Abel Cutlar, and others, reference thereunto being had, to do or act, as the Town shall think best when met.
- 3^d To see, if the Town will grant a suitable sum of Money for the further Encouragement of hiring some suitable Instructor, for the purpose of teaching a singing school, in said Town the present year, it being agreeable to the request of said Society, to do or act &c.
- 4th To see, if the Town will discount, to the several Constables and Collectors belonging to said Town, the Taxes they hold against certain persons, that appear to be unable to discharge the same, — agreeable to the request of Capt. Sam^l May Jr. do or act &c.
- 5th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the purpose of railing the Causeway near Mr. John Haynes, — it being agreeable to the request of said Haynes, to do or act &c.
- 6th To see, if the Town will agreeable to the request of Mr. Isaac Lincoln call upon Mr. Roland Cutlar, to reimburse his part of the wall, between his Land, and the burying yard, to do or act &c.
