At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Tuesday the 9th Day of September 1806, proceeded to the 1st business of said day, and made choice of M^r. William Hunt, for their Moderator, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

Holcomb & others, and after hearing said propositions, by all parties concerned, to accept of that which they shall think will be most for the Interest of the Town, said Committee to receive an Obligation, or Obligations, in behalf of the Town, of any person, or persons, for the faithful performance of Giving their lands and making such part of the road he, or they shall see, fit to offer. — And the Selectmen were appointed, and authorised for the purposes aforesaid, ~ ~ ~

3^d The Question was put, to see, if the Town would grant a suitable sum of Money, for the purpose express in this article, and it pass'd in the affirmative — Then the Town granted the sum of \$ 30.00 and to be under the direction of a Committee appointed for that purpose and the following persons were appointed Viz, M^r. Aaron Haynes Lt. Hapstee Willis, then M^r. Willis dulcird serving on said Committee & Capt. Sam^l. Puffer was appointed in his stead, and M^r. Asahel Wheelock Jr. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~ \$ 30.00
