- 3^d To see if the Town, will take any Measures for the purpose of widening all the public roads in said Town (that appear to be contracted) agreeable to their Original laying out; — also to dispose of such pieces of land as appears to be the Towns property, and not necessary for public use; it being agreeable to the request of Capt. Daniel Bowker, do-or-act &c &c —
- 4th To see if the Town will, agreeable to the request of Capt. Isaac Gibbs, attend to the report of the Selectmen, respecting their proceedings, with Mr. Abel Cutlar on account of the straitening the Worcester Road, from the Brickkiln to Green-Hill and accept of the same, do-or-act &c &c —
- 5th To see, if the Town will take any Measures for Opening the road from Deacon Walkers across the Pine Plains until it comes into the road leading Over Hop Brook (so called) to the Meeting House — do-or-act &c &c —
- 6th To see, if the Town will take any Measures for Repairing, or Rebuilding of the Canal Bridge — do-or-act &c &c —
- 7th To see, if the Town, will discount to the several Constables, & Collectors belonging to said Town, the Taxes they hold against certain persons, that appear to be unable to discharge the same, to do-or-act, &c &c —
