

November Anno Domini 1806

Next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, to Met, at this place,

Sudbury Monday Decr. 1st 1806,

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, provided and took up the 5th Article — and by 5th Their vote, directed the Selectmen, to Notify, the present Owners of the lands, through which the Highway, Mentioned in this Article goes through, to attend at a certain time, they shall agree upon, for the purpose of Renewing & erecting the Bounds of the Highway ^{that} it is expressed under this Article

7th Article, Then the Town, took up this article again & Discounted To Capt. Sam^l Puffer, for Mr. William Moores Taper, being for his son Williams poll Tap for the year 1798

8th Then the Town, took up this article again, and by their vote, appointed a Committee of three Persons, for the purpose of letting out the Rebuilding of the Canal bridge in such a manner, as will be most for the Interest of the Town, as expressed in this article, and the following were appointed Viz^t Mr. Sam^l Jones, Capt. Isaac Gibbs and Col. Jon^s Rice

Then the Town, by their vote, Dissolved this Meeting.
