- 9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of
Compensating M^r. Isaac Puffer, for labour he did, on the New
Road, in the northerly part of the Town, in the fall of the
year of 1805, it being agreeable to the request of M^r. Isaac
Puffer, to do - or act &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town will give their Selectmen any Instructions
how they shall proceed, respecting their perambulating the
line, between the Towns of Sudbury and Stow, do - or act &c &c
- 11th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the purpose of
Rendering less expensive, the Poor belonging to said Town, to do
- or act &c &c
- 12th To see if the Town will suspend the erecting of the Bounds
of a Highway, Layd out through the lands, formerly in the
Possession of Messieurs Josiah Hayden, & Ephraim Gaffield, and now
in the Possession of the Heirs of M^r. John Moore, and appoint a Com-
- mittee to search the Town Records respecting the former Owners of
said lands, being compensated for the same, - it being agreeable
to the request of M^r. Abel Moore, to do - or act &c &c
- 13th To see if the Town, will appoint a Committee to dispose of a
certain part of a road layd out three rods wide from farm-
- ington line, and ending at the County Road near M^r. Eze-
- kiel H. Loring's Dwelling House, part of said road, being layd
out three rods wide upon each side of a certain Edge of Rocks,
it being agreeable to the request of M^r. Ezekiel H. Loring.
- 14th To see, if the Town will agreeable to the Petition of M^r. John
Perry, and Others, (Inhabitants of the South west School district)
Grant or remit to them their part of the Money, they res-
- pectively pay towards the support of public Schools, in the
Town, that the same may be apply'd for the Instructions of
their Children, in the House they have erected for that purpose
Reference being had to said Petition, do - or - act, &c &c
