- also all the Freeholders, and Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the the law directs, to Vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the above-mentioned place, at 3. o'clock in the afternoon, to act on the following Articles, (Viz^t) —
- 1st To Choose a Moderator, — and act upon the 11th Article in the warning of March Meeting and refer, to April Meeting, for further consideration, — — — — —
 - 2^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town Offices which the law requires, should any Office appear to be vacant, — — — — —
 - 3^d To see, if the Town, will discontinue the Highway layd out in 1790, through the lands of Lt. Israel Smith Deceased, to Stow line, — and now in the Possession of M^r. Benjamin Smith, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met, —
 - 4th To see, if the Town, will attend, to any, or all the reports to be made by Committees, should any such reports be offered to be made, — — to do — or act, &c. &c. &c. — — — — —
 - 5th To see, if the Town will, agreeable to the request of M^r. — Ezekiel H. Loring, discontinue and sell, a certain part of a Highway, beginning at Frammingham line, and ending at the County road, Near M^r. Ezekiel H. Loring's dwelling house, part of said road, being layd out three rods wide upon each side of a certain ledge of rocks — to discontinue and sell that part, which lays upon the easterly side of said Ledge of Rocks, — to do — or — act, &c. &c. &c. — — — — —
 - 6th To see, if the Town will agreeable to the request of Doctor Medder, appoint a Committee for the year ensuing, for the purpose of examining and adjusting all such accounts as shall be brought against the Town, for services done —
