Considerable said respecting the Subject Matter of this Article
The Town by Vote directed their Selectmen, to proceed in the
same Manner, with regard to letting out the poor belonging
to said Town (for the present) as they have usually pro-
ceeded in &c. &c.

The Question was then put, to see, if the Town would use their en-
deavours, with regard to assisting the Selectmen, in carrying into
effect, the law ^{contrary to Law} respecting retailers, and Tavern keepers, selling Spi-
rituous Liquor to such people, as the Selectmen have in their
Prohibition Papers posted up at the several retailers & Taverns
in said Town viz, those people, who Mispend, waste, and lessen their
Estates, whereby they are likely, to become chargeable to said Town,
which being put to Vote, it passed in the affirmative -
It was then mov'd that there might be a Committee appointed
for the purpose of devising means, whereby the Poor, might be
rendered less expensive, & to report to the Town, at some fu-
ture meeting, which passed in the Negative.

2^d Article, the Town, at the request of Ruben Maynard excused
him, from serving as Town keeper for the year ensuing.
& Mr. Abel Wheeler Junr. was appointed in his room.

3^d Article not acted upon & private.

4th Article passed over for the present.

5th then the Town took up this article and voted, to discontinue
that part of the road that lays upon the Easterly Side of the
ledge of rocks, as Mentioned in this article up so far as to
leave the road, upon the westerly Side of said ledge three
Rods wide, also voted to appoint a Committee, for the purpose
of selling said road, together with all such land as appears
to be the Towns property, near to and adjoining that part
of said road, that is discontinued under this article, said Com-
mittee to consist of three Persons, and the following were
appointed viz, Capt. Joseph Godnow, Mr. Eben. Plympton
& Capt. Samuel Puffer Jr. and authorized for the purposes
aforesaid.

3^d 4th & 6th Articles refer'd to May Meeting for further

Consideration
The Question was then put to see if the Town would discontinue
the Committee under the 5th Article to sell the road & land & vendue
and it passed in the Negative, then voted to adjourn this Meeting
