

May Anno Domini 1807.

These are to Notify, and warn, the Male Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, being twenty one years of age, and resident in said Town, for the space of One year, next preceding, having a freehold Estate within said Town, of the annual income of three Pounds, or any Estate, to the Value of sixty Pounds, to Meet at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 4th Day of May Next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, on said day, for the purpose of Choosing a Representative, to Represent them at the General Court, appointed to be convened and held at Boston, on the last Wednesday of May Next, —

Also all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the ~~Meeting~~ above mentioned place, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, on said Day, to act on the following articles

Viz: —

1st To Choose a Moderator, and act upon the 3^d, 4th and 6th Article, in the Warning of April Meeting and referred to May Meeting, for further Consideration, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met.

2^d To bring in Town Debts, & Credit, —

3^d To See, if the Town, will Grant to their Rev^d Minister his Salary, for the year ensuing — and also to make an additional Grant, to their Rev^d Minister, to do, or act, &c

4th To See, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Support of a Grammar School, the year ensuing, and Order when the same shall be kept, to do, or act, &c &c &c

5th To See, if the Town will Grant Money, for the Support of a Reading and writing School the year ensuing, and Order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act, &c &c &c

6th To See, if the Town, will Grant Money for the Relief of the Poor belonging to said Town, the year ensuing

7th To See, if the Town, Money, to pay their Treasurer, and Apportion the present year, to do — or act, &c

8th To See, if the Town, will appoint some suitable Person, to take care of and sweep the Meeting-House, during the
