6th Article. in the warning of April Meeting, as contained in this 1st article, the Town by their Vote excused the Selectmen, (at their request) from serving as a Committee for the purposes express in this article, and the following persons were appointed in their stead viz. Col. Jona. Rice, Doct. Medder, Capt. Abel Thompson, M^r. Eben. Plympton & Reuben Maynard

4th & 5th Article. Granted the sum of \$500. for the Support of Public Schools in said Town for the year ensuing to be equally divided, and appropriated, between the five school districts, in the same manner, it was divided, the year last past. 500. " "

also Granted, the sum of \$25. for the purpose of supplying the five school districts with wood, for the year ensuing, to be equally divided between said Districts 25. " "
