7th Granted to pay their Treasurer the sum of 10. " "
To Pay their Officers the sum of 15. " "

8th The Town by their vote, directed their Se-
lectionmen, to agree with, and hire some suit-
able Person, to perform the services ex-
press'd under this article. " " "

9th Voted, to appoint a Committee, for the purpose
of agreeing upon a suitable spot, or spots, of
Land, for a burying yard, or yards, in said Town
and to report to the Town, at some future Meet-
ing, said Committee, to consist of three, & the
following Persons were appointed, Viz. Capt. Ma-
hew Wheeler, Col. Pease & Lt. Joseph Willis -
for the purposes aforesaid. " " "

10th Voted to restrain Neat Cattle, & Horses, from going
at large, without a keeper, as express'd in this
article. " " "

11th Voted, that the same Enactment be gi-
ven to those persons, who shall use the means
of destroying, of crabs, within the limits of said
Town, as was given the year last past, and to
be subject to the same Rules, & Regulations
&c. " " "

12th Voted, to appoint, an agent, in behalf of the To-
wn, as express'd in this article, and to pro-
ceed in said business as it respects the Peti-
tioning the Legislature of this Common-
wealth, for establishing the boundary line
between the Towns of Quebury, & Andover, or any
other way that shall appear to him to
be most eligible, and Mr. William Hunt
was appointed and authorized, for the pur-
poses aforesaid. " " "
