15th The Town, by their vote, directed the selectmen, to proceed & view the Road mentioned in this article, and to report to the Town, the result of their proceedings, as it respects said Road, at the adjournment of this Meeting

6th Article in the warning of April Meeting, and refered to May Meeting as contained in the first article. — The Question was put, to see, if the Town would reconsider the vote respecting the appointment of a Committee, under this article, for the purpose of examining and adjusting accounts brought against the Town, for services done &c. as express in this article, which being put to vote, it past in the affirmative.

13th Attended to the Report of the Committee appointed for the purpose of selling a certain part of a Highway, together with a small piece of land adjoining the same Near Mr. Ezekiel H. Loring's Dwelling House, which report is as follows Viz,

— The Committee, appointed, on the Petition of Ezekiel H. Loring, for the purpose of selling a piece of Road near said Loring's Dwelling House, which has been discontinued; and also all other Lands (being the Towns property) near to, or adjoining said Road

— have attended that Service, and ask leave to report that they found about three Quarters of an acre of land, exclusive of the three rod Road, on the westerly side of the ledge of rocks, and that the Committee agreed with Mr. Loring to sell him, said three Quarters of an acre of land for twenty five Dollars, and that his wall on the westerly side of said ledge of rocks, to the County road, should be the Easterly line of said ^{road} which is left.
