These are to Notify, and warn, all the Freeholders and Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs to vote, in Town affairs, to meet, at the Meeting-House, in said Town, On Monday the 12th Day of October Next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, on said day, then & there, to act on the following Articles Vizt—

1st To Choose a Moderator.

2^d To see, if the Town, will give any further Encouragement than what Government has made Provision for, — for this Towns Proportion of the Soldiers that are called upon, to stand in readiness at a Minutes Notice (Provided) they are called upon to go into actual service, — and grant a suitable Sum of Money for the same. — It being agreeable to the General Orders of the governor of this Commonwealth, — to do or act, as the Town shall think best when met.

3^d To see, if the Town, will accept of some suitable Person as Collector of Taxes for the North Ward, instead of Mr. Abel Moore, who is called upon to stand in readiness at a Minutes Notice, to go into actual service, it being agreeable to the request of said Moore, — to do or act &c &c
