- 4th To see if the Town will accept of a Highway as Laid out by the Selectmen from M^r. Jona^s. Fairbanks to M^r. John Perry's Mills, it being agreeable to the request of Said Fairbanks - to do - or act &c &c
- 5th To see, if the Town will make any Provision, for the purpose of taking up Outstanding Orders, that are held against Said Town - do or act &c &c
- 6th To see, if the Town, will Grant a Suitable Sum of Money, for the further repairs of Highways, in Said Town - to do - or act &c &c
- 7th To see if the Town, will attend, to any, or all of the reports to be made by Committees, Should any such reports be offered to be made, - to do - or - act, &c &c
- 8th To see, if the Town, will discontinue the old road Near M^r. William Smiths and accept of the New road, as it is now ~~made~~ made by Said Smith, Said New road being made a Little East of the old road, to do - or act &c &c
- 9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures (different ^{from} what has hitherto been done) Respecting the taking care of, and sweeping the Meeting House, Ringing the Bell, and Digging of Graves, as Occasion may require - it being agreeable to the Petition of M^r. Abel Moore & Others, reference thereunto being had - do - or - act &c
