At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday
the 12th Day of October 1807 Proceeded to the business of said
1st Day, by making choice of Col^l. Jonathan Rice for their
Moderator, —

2^d Article, after a considerable time spent in the discussion of
the subject matter of this article, the Question was put, To
wth of the Town, would give to each Soldier that is called
upon to stand at a Minutes Notice, — and shall be called
upon to go into actual service, the sum of \$12, p^r man.

3^d Article Including what government has made pro-
-vision for, during the time they are in actual service,
and six dollars to each Soldier, as advance pay, that shall
Equip himself for said service, — the aforesaid six dollars to
be paid Previous to his Marching, if called upon, & to be sub-
-ject to a deduction from his wages, which Question being
put to Vote, it passed in the affirmative —

— It was then voted, that their Treas^r be directed, to pay
to this Towns Quota of Soldiers, six dollars, in advance pay
to each Soldier who shall Equip himself, (Provided they are
called upon) out of any unappropriated Money now in the
Treasury, and if there is not a sufficient Sum in the
Treasury, to Borrow the deficiency upon the Towns credit

— also directed their Treas^r to pay, to each Soldier af-
-oresaid, after his return from service, six dollars p^r
Month, including advance pay, out of any unappropriated
Money that shall be in the Treasury, and if there is
not a sufficient Sum in the Treasury, to borrow the re-
mainder upon the Towns credit, —

6th Article Voted, to Grant a Sum of Money, for the further re-
-pair of their Highways, — It was then Mov^d that
the Sum of four Hundred dollars, be Granted
which being put to Vote it passed in the Negative
