

October Anno Domini 1807—

6th Granted the sum of three hundred dollars for the purpose of repairing the three great roads leading through the Town, one hundred dollars to be expended upon each of the aforesaid roads, and to be laid out under the direction of the Selectmen, ————— \$300. "

7th attended to the report of the Committee for searching the records respecting the road from Mr. Fairbank's to Mr. Perry's Mill, who reported, that they could find nothing on Record, respecting said road, —————

8th Then the Town by their vote, directed the Selectmen to Proun & View the road, that is mentioned under this article, and to report to the Town, the situation of said road, at some future meeting —————

4th Then the Town took up this article again, and accepted of the Road as laid out by the Selectmen, as mentioned in this article, and ordered the same to be recorded, —————

— also the Town by their vote, at the request of Mr. Fairbank gave him liberty, to work out the remainder of his highway Taxes, upon the Highway laid out under this article, —————

7th attended to the report of the Committee, being the Selectmen, respecting their renarrowing & erecting of Bounds upon the land left for a road leading through the lands of John Moore Ocutt & Abel Moore, who reported, that they had attended to said business, & brought in their report in writing, and after said report was read before the Town, the Question was put, to see if they would put over the further consideration of this report to March Meeting, and it passed in the Negative —————

— The Question was then put, to see if the Town would accept of said report, as exhibited by the Selectmen and it passed in the Negative —————

6th ————— Then the Town by their vote directed their Assessors to make their grant, for the repair of highways into a Rate forthwith —————

9th passed over, after a few observations made upon said Article —————
