Then the Town took up this article again, and the
Question was asked, to see if the Town would recon-
sider their appropriation of \$300, to be layd out
upon the three great roads, leading through the
Town, which being put to vote, it passed in the neg-
ative

It was then voted, that the selectmen be directed
to call upon the several delinquent Surveyors of high-
ways, who have Money in their hands, to work out the
remainder of said Money, under the direction of the
selectmen upon such Cross roads, as they shall think
appear, to be most in need of repairs, although it
be out of the limits assigned them, by the selectmen,

Then the Town by Vote, dissolved this Meeting

These are to Notify and warn the Freeholders &
Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury Quali-
fied as the Law directs, to vote, in Town affairs, to Meet
at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the
7th Day of March Next, at 10 o'clock in the fore noon
on said Day, then and there, to act on the following
articles Viz^t

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, selectmen, Town
Treas^r, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town offi-
cers required by Law, to be annually chosen in
the Months of March, or April

2^d To see, if the Town will repair their Highways
by a rate, the present year, and Grant a suit-
able sum of Money for repairing the same,

3^d To see, if the Town will give liberty for Swine
to go at large the present year,
