1st Then the Town took up the 1st Article in the warning of the other Meeting, & made choice of Capt. Abel Thompson for their Moderator, — then the Town at the request of Capt. Thompson, excused him from serving as Moderator, & Capt. Samuel Puffer Jr. was chosen in his stead, —

It was then voted, that the Clerk, should to read certain Laws, that are incumbent on him to read, either in the Months, of March, or April, Previous to their providing to act on Town business —

2^d Article Provided to bring in their Votes, for the choice of a County Treasurer, as follows Vizt. —

3^d Article Excused M^r. John Goodnow Jr., at his request from serving as Highway Surveyor, in the S. East district, and M^r. Curtis Moore was appointed in his room, —

Also the Town, made choice of M^r. Abel Dakin, for Surveyor of Highways, in the S. west district —

Also by their Vote, made choice of M^r. Walter Haynes for their Constable, for the year ensuing, — who was the same evening sworn to the faithful Discharge of his duty, by the Clerk of said Town, —

1st Article. — the 6th Article in the warning of March Meeting and Referred to April Meeting, as Contained in this 1st Article accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r. and Ordered the same to be recorded, — which is as it stands hereafter recorded —

4th The Town by their Vote, directed their Assessors, to go to every Mans house, that is liable to be taxed in said Town for the purpose of taking an Invoice of his Personal Estate, to proceed on said business, on or before the first Day of May next, and continue in said business untill completed —
