10th The Question was put to see, if the Town would take any measures, for the purpose of procuring a suitable Number of Ploughs, for the Towns Use, as express'd in this article and it pass'd in the Negative — — —

11th The Question was asked to see, if the Town, would appoint some suitable person, for the purpose of making provision, as it respects Materials, for the rebuilding the Shute-ways Mentioned in this article, & it pass'd in the Negative —

12th Granted, the sum of \$50. " for the purpose of keeping good, the Town Stock of Ammunition, &c. &c. &c. \$50. "

— also — the Town by their vote, directed their Selectmen, to procure said Ammunition sufficient to answer the requisitions, in the law, in that behalf made and provided — — —

13th The Town by their vote, directed their Treas.^r to call upon the several Collectors belonging to said Town, as soon as may be for the purpose of satisfying the demand, of M^r. Abel Willis, as Mentioned in this article —

14th Voted, that the same Encouragement be given, to those Persons who shall destroy Crows within the Limits of said Town, for the year Ensuing, as was given the year past, Viz. \$¹¹ 25 cents, for an old one & 12½ cents for a young One, — also to carry in said crows to the Selectmen, in Order to obtain a Certificate, for the bounty —

15th Attended to the report of the Committee appointed for the purpose of Looking out a suitable Spot of Ground Land, for a burying yard, who reported that M^r. William Hayden had a small piece of Land, and very
