Sudbury Monday May 23rd 1808

The Town being Mett at time and place agreeable to the
foregoing adjournment provided, and Voted to adjourn
this Meeting for half an hour, for the purpose of taking
up the other warrant, for accepting the list of Jurors.

Then the Town, after completing the business contained
in the other warrant, Resumed their Meeting agreeable to
the foregoing adjournment proceeded to the business of
said day and Granted the sum of \$50, " for the
purpose of repairing the Canal Bridge, and to be Un-
der the direction of the Committee appointed for that
purpose, they to be accountable to the Town, for the ex-
penditure thereof \$50, "

Granted, the sum of \$30, " for the purpose of settling
the amount brought forward, by L^t. Caleb Wheeler, &
Capt. Jon^a. Bent, for Labour done on the Highways
by several persons, - in the fall of the year 1807, the
Selectmen, to be a Committee, to settle with said persons up-
on as reasonable terms as Possible, said Committee
to be accountable to the Town, for the expenditure
thereof
