These are to notify, and warn, all the Freeholders, and Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House in Said Town, on Monday the 23^d Day of this Instant May, at 3 o'clock in the afternoon, on ^{Sa} Day, to act on the following articles, Viz^t —

1st To choose a Moderator —

2^d To see, if the Town will accept of the list of Jurors, as Presented by the Selectmen, to do, or act as the Town shall think best when Met.
