

Nov^r Anno Domini 1808.

These are to Notify and warn, the Male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury being twenty One years of age and Resident in said Town for the space of one year next preceding, having a freehold Estate within said Town, of the annual Income of three pounds, or any Estate to the Value of sixty Pounds, to assemble at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the 7th Day of Nov^r Next, being the first Monday in said Month, at 10 o'clock in the afternoon to give in their Votes, for a Representative of the People of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the Congress of the United States, for the Second Middle District;

— Also, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as the Law directs, to vote, in Town affairs, to assemble at the above-mentioned place, at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, on said Day, to act on the following articles, Viz^t —

1st To Choose a Moderator —

2^d To see, if the Town will Discount to the several Constables, and collectors the Taxes they hold against certain Persons belonging to said Town, who appear to be unable to pay the same, to do, or act as the Town shall think best when Met, —

3^d To see, if the Town, will appropriate a suitable sum of Money, Now in the Treasury (if any there be) (and not otherwise appropriated) for the purpose of hiring an Instructor, to teach a Singing School in said Town, the present year, it being agreeable to the request of said Society — to do — or act &c &c —

4th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of building a wall, upon each Side of Cold Brook Causeway, So called, Near Eastⁿ Jonathan Bents, to do — or act &c &c —

5th To see, if the Town, will attend, to any, or all —
