- 3^d Resolved that we have seen with regret certain Resolutions denouncing all good Citizens who shall give their aid and support in the execution of the Embargo laws, such resolutions may produce riots and Insurrections but they produce on our minds a determination when legally called, to give said laws our prompt and undivided support
- 4th Resolved that as the Management of our foreign relations is exclusively delegated to the Councils of the Nation we deem it inexpedient for our State legislator to Interfere
- Then the Town by their Vote, dissolved this Meeting —

- These are to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified as the laws Direct to vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 6th Day of March Next at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, on said day then and there to act on the following articles Viz^t
- 1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town Officers, required by law, to be annually chosen in the Months of March or April
- 2^d To see, if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate, the present year, and grant a suitable sum of Money for repairing the same,
- 3^d To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Swine to go at large the present year,
- 4th To see, if the Town, will give liberty for Horses to go at large without fetters any part of the present
