

May Anno Domini 1809

There are to Notify, and warn, the Male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury being twenty One years of age, and resident in said Town, for the space of one year, Next preceding, having a freehold Estate within said Town, of the annual Income of three Pounds, or any Estate, to the Value of Sixty Pounds, to Meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 1st Day of May Next, at 12 o'clock at Noon, on said Day, for the Purpose of choosing one or more Representatives, to Represent them at the General Court, appointed to be convened and held at Boston, on the last Wednesday of May Next,

Also all the Freeholders, and Other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, ~~at the Meeting-House~~ at the above mentioned Place at 1 o'clock in the afternoon on said Day,

to act on the following articles Viz^t
1st To Choose a Moderator, and act upon 9th Article in the warning of March Meeting, and Refer'd to May Meeting for further consideration

2^d To bring in Town Debts, and Credit

3^d To see, if the Town will Grant to their Prev^d Minister his Salary, for the year ensuing, and also to see if the Town will make an additional Grant to their Prev^d Minister, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met,

4th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School, the year ensuing, and Order where the same shall be kept, to Do or act, &c

5th To see, if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Reading and writing School, the year ensuing, & Order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act, &c

6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the relief of the Poor, belonging to said Town, the year ensuing

7th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money to pay their Treasurer, & Assessors, the present year, to do or act, &c
