

May Anno Domini 1809.

- 8th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable Sum of Money, for the Purpose of defraying the Extra Expence of the Town, the year Ensuing, to do or act &c
- 9th To see, if the Town will grant a suitable Sum of Money for the purpose of walling the Casway upon each Side of Cold brook bridge, also for the building the Butments of Said Bridge, to do or act &c
- 10th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable Person, to take care of and sweep the Meeting-House Ring the Bell, and dig graves, as Occasion may require, — to do or act &c
- 11th To see, if the Town will give liberty to dispose of a small piece of land in Cedar Swamp, formerly the Property of Eunice Haynes, and lying in Common & undivided, with a piece of Land, belonging to the Estate of Moses Haynes, to do or act &c
- 12th To see, if the Town, will give any encouragement to those Persons, who shall use the means for destroying of Crows, within the limits of said Town the year ensuing, to do, or act &c
- 13th To see, if the Town, will attend to any, or all the reports to be made by Corn-mithers, Should any reports be offered to be made, to do or act &c
- 14th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable Sum of Money, for the Purpose of Purchasing a Stove for the School-House in the North-East district — also for repairing the several School-Houses belonging to said Town, — to do or act &c
