11th Article Voted to appoint a Committee for the purpose of disposing of the Land Mentioned in this article said Committee to consist of One, and M^r. Asahel Wheeler Jun^r was chosen and authorized to sell, and give a Deed, in behalf of the Town, of the Land Mentioned in this article, said Land to be sold in Common and undivided with the Land belonging to the Estate of M^r. Haynes

12th Article Passed over

13th Passed over for the present

14th Granted, the Sum of \$25, for the purpose of furnishing a Stove for the School-House in the North East district, - also by their vote appointed Licut. Caleb Wheeler, for the purpose of Procuring said Stove, also directed him to provide such an one as will answer the Purpose, and in case, the Grant be insufficient to purchase such a one as will answer the purpose - then he may advance 25, the overplus, & bring in his account to the Town for the extra expence, if any there be, - Then the Town at the request of M^r. Wheeler, excused him from his appointment, and M^r. William Hunt was chosen in his stead, and authorized for the purposes aforementioned
