These are to Notify, and warn all the Free-
holders, and other Inhabitants of the Town of
Sudbury, Qualified as the law directs, to Vote, in
Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House in
said Town, on Monday the 5th Day of March
Next at 10, o'clock in the forenoon, on said Day
then and there to act on the following Articles Viz^t
1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town
Treas^r, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town Of-
ficers, required by law, to be annually chosen, in the
Months, of March, or April
2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways by
a rate, the present year, and Grant a suitable
Sum of Money, for repairing the same,
3^d To see if the Town, will give Liberty for Swine
to go at large the present year,
4th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Horses
to go at large without fetters, any part of the pre-
sent year, from the first day of April to the
last Day of Sept^r
5th To see if the Town, will give Liberty for Sheep
to go at large from the 15th Day of March to the
first day of May Next,
