6th To see, if the Town will accept the Settlement
of the Settlement with the Town Treasurer and Order
the same to be recorded,

7th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable
Persons, for a School-Committee, and authorise them
to agree with and hire School Instructors, to In-
struct the Public Schools in said Town, the year
ensuing, to do, or act, as the Town shall think
best when met,

8th To see, if the Town will take any Measures for the
purpose of agreeing with some suitable person, or
Persons, for collector, or collectors, to collect the Taxes,
Assessed upon the Inhabitants of said Town, for the
year ensuing, to do, or act, &c &c

9th To see, if the Town will discount to M^r. Walter
Haynes, such Taxes, as he holds against certain persons
that are Taxed in said Town, for the year 1808, which
shall appear unable to pay said Taxes, to do, or act, &c

10th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the
purpose of discharging a certain promissory Note, be-
ing in favor of M^r. John Maynard, late of Sudbury
Quard, and signed by M^r. John Green, to do or act, &c

11th To see, if the Town will give any direction respect-
ing the Cutting and disposing of such a Quantity
of wood, of, of the land of the Widow Towers as shall
be judged sufficient to support one fire such a
term of time as she has been chargeable to said
Town, — to do — or, act &c &c
