These are to notify, and warn, all the ~~Freeholders and other~~
Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified by law, as is
provided in the constitution of this Commonwealth to vote
in the choice of Gov^r. Leut^t. Gov^r. and Senators, for the year
Ensuing, to meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on
Monday the 2^d Day of April Next, at 1 o'clock in the
Afternoon, on said Day to give in their Votes, for the choice
of Gov^r. Leut^t. Gov^r. and Senators for the year Ensuing—

also all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of
the Town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs, to vote
in Town affairs to meet at the abovementioned place
at 2 o'clock in the afternoon, to act on the following
articles, Viz^t—

1st To choose a Moderator and act upon the 10th Article
in the warning of March Meeting, and refer to April
Meeting for further Consideration.

2^d To bring in their Votes, for ^{the choice of} some suitable person
for a County Treasurer—

3^d To fill up vacancies in those Town offices, which
the Law requires, should any office appear to be
vacant,

4th To see if the Town will appoint a Com^{tee} for the
purpose of making such repairs to the School-House
in the Northeast district, as shall appear to be
necessary, it being agreeable to the request of Capt^t
Jarr^l. Puffer jun^r to do or act, as the Town shall
think proper when met

5th To see if the Town, will take any Measures, for the pur-
pose of restraining Next Cattle and Horses going at
large without a keeper, the present season
to do or, act &c &c
