5th To see, if the Town will grant Money, for the support of a Reading and writing School the year ensuing and order where the same shall be kept, to do, or act &c. &c.

6th To see, if the Town will grant Money, for the relief of the poor, belonging to said Town, the year ensuing.

7th To see, if the Town will grant Money, to pay their Treasurer, & Affessor, the present year, to do or act &c. &c.

8th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable Person, to take care of, and sweep the Meeting-House Ring, the Bell, & dig Graves as Occasion may require, the year ensuing, to do or act &c. &c.

9th To see, if the Town, will appoint an agent to appear in behalf of said Town, at the Court of common Pleas Next to be holden at Concord, in and for the County of Middlesex, on the Monday next preceeding the first Tuesday of June Next, to answer to an Indictment for Neglecting to repair a certain piece of Highway in said Town, to do or act &c. &c.

10th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the Purpose of Rebuilding the Monument Near Mr. Gideon Richardson, to do or act &c. &c.

11th To see, if the Town, will direct their Treas^r, to receive a certain five dollar Bill, of Constable Walter Haynes, which he took in the collection of Taxes to do or act &c. &c.

12th To see, if the Town will Discount to Constable Walter Haynes, such Taxes, as he holds against certain persons that are taxed in said Town, for the year 1808, which are illegally taxed, or appear to be unable to pay their taxes, to do or act &c. &c.
