Then Voted to adjourn this Meeting to the first
Monday in September Next, at, 1 o'clock in the after-
noon, to meet at this place

be Equally Divided between the five School
Districts ————— 445, ..

5th Granted for the support of a Reading & wri-
ting school, for the year ensuing, the sum
of \$125, to be Equally Divided between the
five School Districts ————— 125, ..

Also Granted the sum of \$25 to supply
the several school districts with wood the year
ensuing to be equally divided between said
Districts ————— 25
