At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on Monday the 3^d Day of September 1810, Provided, and took up the first article & made choice of 1st Art.) — Mr. William Hunt for their Moderator, —

2^d Voted, to hire some suitable person, or persons, for the purpose of preaching, during the fall & winter months, provided the Rev. Mr. Bigelow should remain to be unable to supply the Desk, as expressed in this article, — also voted to appoint a Committee, to procure some suitable person, or persons, for that purpose, — said Committee to consist of three, and the following persons were chosen — Viz. Mr. Abel Wheeler, Mr. Paul Walker, and Lieut. Caleb Wheeler and fully authorized, for the purpose aforesaid

— Also Granted, the sum of £26, for the Purpose of Defraying the expense arising in consequence of procuring said Preaching

3^d Art. Directed, their Treas^r to collect a certain Promissory Note, in favor, of the Town, Now in his hands of the Sum of \$25, exclusive of Interest, and to appropriate said Sum, as far as it will answer, towards taking up — outstanding Orders against said Town and Discharging the discounts, in part, that were made under the Warrant for May Meeting,

— Also Granted, the Sum of \$25, in Addition to what has been already appropriated, for the purpose of paying up the Remainder of the Discounts, as above mentioned — \$25, "

2^d the Town took up this article again, & by their Vote, Reconsidered the Grant of £26, for the purpose of Defraying the expense of providing for preach- 255.1
