You are hereby required in the name of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts, to Notify and warn, the Free-
holders, and other Inhabitants, of said Town, Qualified
by Law, to vote in Town Meetings, Viz^t Such as pay to one
single Tax, besides the poll, or polls, a sum equal to two
thirds of a single poll tax, (by posting up a Copy of the
same, agreeable to the order of the Town) to Assemble at
the Meeting House in said Town, on Monday the 4th Day
of March Next, at 10^o Clock in the Forenoon, on said Day
then & there, to act on the following articles, Viz^t
1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas-
urer, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town officers
Required by Law, to be annually chosen in the
Months, of March, or April,
