- 2^d article To see, if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate the present year, and grant a Suitable Sum of Money for repairing the same,
- 3^d To see, if the Town will give Liberty for Swine to go at Large the present year,
- 4th To see, if the Town will give Liberty, for Horses to go at Large, with, or without, fetters, any part of the present year,
- 5th To see, if the Town will give Liberty, for Sheep to go at Large, from the 15th Day of March, to the first Day of May next,
- 6th To see, if the Town will accept the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r and order the same to be Recorded,
- 7th To see, if the Town will appoint some Suitable Person, for a School-Committee and authorise them to agree with, and Hire School Instructors, to instruct the Public Schools in Said Town, the year ensuing — to do, or act as the Town shall think best when Mett,
- 8th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the Purpose of agreeing with some Suitable person, or Person, for collector, or Collectors, to collect, the Taxes assessed upon the Inhabitants of Said Town, for the year ensuing, to do — or — act &c &c
- 9th To see, if the Town, will discount to Constable Walter Haynes for the year 1809, such Taxes as he holds against certain persons, belonging to Said Town, as shall appear to be unable to pay the same, or that are unreasonably taxed, to do — or act, &c &c
- 10th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for the purpose of repairing the several School-Houses in Said Town, to do — or act, &c &c
- 11th To see if the Town, will take any Measures for the purpose of procuring some Suitable person to supply
