estate, of said Rice, in behalf of the Town, as Security, for
the same, as express in this article, = and Capt. Joseph
Goodnow, was chosen, and fully authorised for the pur-
poses aforesaid.

14th article in the warning, of March Meeting, and refer^d
to April Meeting = attended to the report of the Se-
lectmen, respecting their appointment at March Meet-
ing, for the purpose of agreeing with some suitable
person or persons to collect the Taxes assess^d upon the
Inhabitants of said Town, for the year ensuing.
Who Reported they had agreed with M^r. Walter
Haynes, for One per cent, for collecting the Taxes pro-
vided he could have the privilege of being Con-
stable for said Town.
