the time and place and for the purposes within Mentioned
Sudbury August, 12th 1811 Walter Haynes } Com^{tee}

Sudbury Monday August, 12th 1811

At a Town Legally held in Sudbury, on the day & year above
said, Proceeded, to the business of said day, and took up the
1st Article, and made choice of Col^o. Jon^a. Rice for their
Moderator

2^d Article, It was then Moved and Second to see, if the Town
would hear some New Candidates for preaching in said
Town, which being put to vote it passed in the affirma-
tive, 59 for hearing New candidates & 32 against it
It was then voted to appoint a Com^{tee} for the purpose
of Procuring said Candidates to preach, said Com^{tee} to con-
sist of three and to be chosen by Ballot, and the fol-
lowing Persons were chosen (Viz^t) Deacon Sam^l. Puffer
Mr. Nathan Goodnow, and Mr. Adam How,

It was also voted, that said Com^{tee} be authorized & em-
powered, to procure said Candidates for the purpose of
Preaching During the Towns Pleasure, by 44. to 35 against it
Then Voted, to adjourn this Meeting, to the first
Monday in October next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon
to Met at this place,

Sudbury Monday Oct^r. 7th 1811

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing
adjournment, Proceeded and took up the 3^d Arti- 271.1
