lately preached here Preach any further, which being put to Vote it
Pass'd in the affirmative

It was then Voted to reconsider the vote last past

2nd Article The Town took up this article again, and the Question
was put to see if the Town would hire Mr. Sewal Preach
any further term of time, which was put to Vote ^{and} pass'd in the
Negative

The Question was then put to see, if the Town would
take any Measures, for the purpose of procuring some suit-
= able Person to preach in future in said Town, which was put
to Vote & pass'd in the affirmative

The Question was then put to see if the Town would hire Mr.
Randall, for the term of six Months, to supply the Pulpit and
it pass'd in the negative, by 49. to 48.

The Question was then ask'd, to see, if the Town would
hire Mr. Randall for One year to supply the pulpit and
to take up his residence in the Town, and to perform all
Ministerial duties which being put to Vote, pass'd in the
negative, by 50. to 49.

Then Voted to Dissolve this Meeting
